

***Psychology Internship Program  
Program Completion Requirements***

1. Completion of 2000 hours of training.
2. Completion of 500 hours of direct clinical services. Direct clinical service includes all clinical activities which encompasses individual, family, and group psychotherapy, consultations, and psychological assessments.
3. Completion of all internship placements (integrated primary care, outpatient mental health, and psychosocial rehabilitation).
4. Participation in 4 hours of weekly supervision, including 3 hours of individual supervision and 1 hour of group supervision.
5. All competency areas should be a minimum of “5” by the end of the third trimester period. No competency ratings should be rated as “3” or lower.
  - NOTE: Any concerns about an intern’s level of competency achievement will be addressed as soon as possible (prior to any evaluation deadline). A remedial plan will be developed by the clinical supervisor, mentor, intern, and training director in order to facilitate achievement of the minimum competency ratings.
6. Attendance of didactic training seminars.
7. Satisfactory completion of all clinical health record documentation.
8. Completion of three public advocacy activities.
9. Completion of other placement site specific requirements as determined and reviewed by placement supervisor.
